COVID-19 POLICIES (PLEASE LET YOUR PUBLIC AND FANS KNOW):

Fans/Spectators: Temp checks will be taken at door for anybody entering the building. **Masks will be required and enforced at all times while in the building.** Anybody with a temperature at 100.4 or over will not be allowed in. Will check 3 times.

Please let your fans know the above requirements. **Without question we want to avoid confrontation, but we will address anybody not wearing a mask for prolonged periods of time.** We appreciate your cooperation and assistance letting the fans know.

Players/Coaches: Masks required for players and coaches when not playing while in the building. Temperature checks can be done at the home site as long as documentation is given to an administrator upon arrival (roster with names and temperature recorded. Temp checks can also be done upon arrival by our event managers at the door.

2. **Entry fee** is \$150 per school.
3. **Pool Play** will start at 9:00 AM.
4. **Warm-up:** For all teams, prior to their first match of the day – 20 minutes (4 min shared, 4 min home team, 4 min visitor, 4 min home team, 4 min visitor) All remaining rounds, 8 minutes (2 min shared, 3 min home team, 3 min visitor).
5. We will be using two gyms with three courts. Gym A will be set up with two courts and Gym B will have one court. We will use the first available court for the matches following 9:00 AM.
6. After 9:00, the start times are an estimate only. **We will play ahead of the listed time if courts become available and teams are ready to go.** There will be a lunch break in the Hospitality Room following pool play for coaches, officials, and table workers to have a chance to eat.
7. The team listed first in pool play will be considered the home team.
8. Teams on the top of the bracket will be considered the home team.
9. **All Teams must plan to provide an adult line judge for each of your team's matches. If you have 1 to 2 adults who will do all your matches, there is a line to include them on the pass list/roster.**
10. **Teams must plan on providing a libero tracker for their matches, if they are using a libero.**
11. Bracket match-ups will be determined by win/loss record from pool play.
 - a. If two teams tie, the team defeating the other in pool play will advance.
 - b. If three or more teams tie, the percentage of games won in pool play will be used to determine the top team(s). If one team is identified and two remain tied, results of head-to-head competition in pool play will determine the second team.
 - c. If a tie still remains, a point differential **among those teams involved in the tie** will be used to determine the top team(s). If one team is identified using this procedure and two remain tied, then the result of their head-to-head competition in pool play will determine second team.
12. The top 2 teams from both pools will advance to the Gold Championship bracket and will cross pool #1A plays #2B and #1B plays #2A. Winners will play for the championship, and the two teams that lost will play for 3rd place. The bottom 2 teams from both pools will advance to the Consolation Silver Bracket and will cross pool #3A plays #4B and #4A plays #3B. Winners will play for 5th place, and the two teams that lost will play for 7th place. All teams will be guaranteed 5 matches.
13. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place team medals will be awarded. We will have an all-tournament team, which coaches will vote on players from all other teams. Voting Ballots will be given to Head Coaches upon arrival.
14. Hays High will furnish practice balls. Locker rooms will be available for changing purposes only and will be designated. Athletes need to take their belongings with them after changing. Team camps will be set up in the dining hall.
15. PLEASE FURNISH YOUR OWN TEAM TOWELS.
16. A concession stand will be available. A hospitality room will be available for coaches, administrators, officials, bus drivers, and tournament workers.

17. Team coolers can be brought in by the team and are only allowed in the dining area. No parent coolers will be allowed and only teams are allowed to eat from team coolers in the dining area. **Because space is limited and for clean-up purposes, only team members will be allowed in the dining area.** No outside food or drink will be allowed.
18. PLEASE PARK IN THE SOUTH END OF THE WEST PARKING LOT.
