Track Coaches and Athletic Directors:

Enclosed is the schedule for the 87th SCHS Invitational Relays. Other information concerning the relays is listed below.

1. The field events will begin at 9:30 A.M. Field event participants are to report to the event area.
2. At the coaches meeting (9:00 A.M. CDT), we will make necessary changes and will heat after the changes. Please, NO additions-scratches only.
3. Remember, a participant can only be in four events total.
4. No tents, radios, Frisbees, or throwing implements are allowed inside the track area. *Please stay off the football field*
5. You may enter three participants per event.
6. We will have the finish line area flagged off, and we ask that you explain to your managers, ect., that they are not to add to the congestion.
7. Scoring will be 10-8-6-4-2-1. Medals will be awarded to individuals 1-3 and for the relays 1-3. Plaques will be presented to the champions. We will have the medals in envelopes to be picked up after the meet.
8. All starting heights will be decided at the coaches meeting. Please send a copy of your pole vaults' weight verifications, Form 2003, before the meet starts.
9. Entry fees: \$70.00 boys team and \$70.00 girls team.
10. We will run a Boys and Girls 4 X 100 Wt. Relay – must be in throwing events only. NO team points will be awarded for this event.
