Tournament Location:

The tournament will be held in the Trego Community High School Gym located at 1200 Russell Avenue. The gym is on the right along Highway 283 if coming from the north. If coming from the south follow Highway 283 and the school is just north of the football field. If coming from east or west take Exit 128 and go north.

Parking:

You may unload your wrestlers on the east side of the school. **The pass gate will be located at the east door of the school. Pass Gate will open at 9:00 am. We ask that you park your bus on the fairgrounds east of the school after you unload your wrestlers. Please park suburbans on fairgrounds as well.**

Seeding Meeting:

No Seeding required as Qualifiers from District #1 and #2 feed this tournament.

Entry Information:

Top 4 placers from District #1 and District #2 will be placed in an 8-man bracket from KSHSAA. Make sure to have WR-RG emailed to jsamson@tregoeagles.com by 12:00 pm on February 10.

We will be running live scoring for this event on trackwrestling.com

Pass Gate:

Be sure to include your pass gate by February 10, 2021. The pass gate for teams and school personnel will be located just inside the east entrance of the high school. Please inform all those on the pass list to use that entrance to get stamped.

Officials:

The officials will be assigned by the state.

Locker Rooms:

Each school will be assigned locker rooms as listed below. You will be sharing locker rooms and it may be crowded. No towels will be provided, therefore, you must supply your own. In addition, Trego Community High School will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Please secure your valuables. Locker room assignments will be assigned as your teams enter the building.

Substitutions:

Any substitutions will be handled as outlined in the KSHSAA Wrestling Manual.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded following the match in the next weight class during the championship matches.

Weigh-Ins:

Weigh-ins will start at 10:00 am and the check scale will open at 9:00 am.

Hospitality Rooms:

A hospitality room for workers, bus drivers, officials, coaches, and administrators will be available in the woodshop classroom located adjacent to the east entrance of the school.

Inclement Weather:

Please fax the inclement weather form to 785-743-2449 by 12:00 pm on Feb. 10.

Schedule:

Wrestling will begin at 12:00 pm on two mats. We will wrestle straight through taking minimal breaks to clean mats between rounds.

Concession Stand:

We will not be providing a concession stand.

Mat Area:

Only tournament officials, workers, cheerleaders, coaches, and wrestlers will be allowed on the mat area. Please work with your administrators, coaches, and sponsors to help keep the mat area free from others.

Team Camps:

Each team will be allowed to set up camp in our Auxiliary gym where half of the locker rooms are. Teams may have their coolers and bags in there; this will help with some of the congestion in the main gym area.

Brackets:

A 8 man bracket will be utilized for this event. The KSHSAA has established guidelines in the event of this, and we will seeded accordingly.
